Mrs Hunter and Miss Taylor will work with classes throughout the school, providing teachers with Non-Class Contact time.

#### Structure of the Day

School starts for all children at 8.55am.

This session, P1 children will have morning playtime at 10.00am. All other children will have their morning break at 10.30am.

Lunch times are as follows:

P1-P4 - 12.00-12.45pm

P5-P7 - 12.45pm-1.30pm

Our curriculum in P1 is play based and a lot of time is spent in our outdoor area.

Each afternoon the children enjoy a short break, where the teacher reads a story and the children are encouraged to eat a piece of fruit as a snack. If your child is in P1, please provide a piece of fruit each day for this purpose.

Children in P2 and beyond do not have a formal break in the afternoons, so there is no need to provide an additional snack.

#### **Snacks**

Please remember that we are a nut free school. Please do not send children to school with foods containing any nut products as we have children in our school community with allergies.

Also, for safety reasons, children should not bring hard boiled sweets or lollipops as a snack.

If children have grapes, please ensure that they have been cut lengthways as this helps prevent the risk of choking.

Fizzy drinks and energy drinks are not allowed in school

I understand that many parents want their child to have a choice of snack at playtime, however, please avoid giving your child more than one or two items as they only have a twenty-minute break in which to eat their snack and play with friends and some children are becoming overwhelmed when the bell rings to return to class and they still have snacks left.

#### End of the Day Procedures

As you know, our children exit the school from three different gates. Please note which gate your child will exit from, as this may be different to last session.

If you require your child to pick up a sibling and exit from a different gate, please let the class teacher know.

Please note, at the end of the day only the parents of P1 children are allowed into the playground.

#### Morning Drop Off

Please do not drop your child at school any earlier than <u>8.45am</u> unless they are attending breakfast club. There is no adult presence in the playground until **8.45am**.

Children who attend Breakfast Club should enter the gate at the side of the dining room and walk round the side of the building. Breakfast Club opens at 8.15am

Parents are not allowed to enter the playground in the morning, unless dropping a child at Breakfast Club.
